Where do our patients come visit us from?

In 2013, Achievable Health opened a first-of-its kind community health center in California focusing on the unmet healthcare needs of individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) and their families. That same year, we were granted a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) designation giving Achievable Health an opportunity to receive federal funding to cover a portion of its total cost. More than 10 years later, Achievable Health is proudly serving patients in multiple cities across the Greater Los Angeles Area.

As pictured below, Achievable has grown in size over the years, averaging more than 2,400 patients a year. With our health center's location being in Culver City, we receive most of our patients from all over Los Angeles County and **28 adjacent zip codes**, with our biggest populations visiting our health center from Los Angeles city, Culver City, and Inglewood.

Our mission is only **achievable** with the partnership and support of our generous donors and supporters, like you. We encourage you to **give the gift of health**, and consider making a donation to our cause.


