Under the direct supervision of the Chief Medical Officer (CMO) the Licensed Vocational Nurse is responsible for assisting providers with procedures, performing nursing procedures and assisting the Health Center Supervisor in maintaining optimal patient flow. This work will be done while using principles of trauma informed care and embracing a Justice, Equity, Diversity, Inclusion + Belonging (JEDI +B) lens.
